## **Transfer Station Guide 2011-2012**

### **The Transfer Station is for garbage and recyclables only from Salisbury & Sharon**

Whether or not you use a hauler, *recycling is mandatory*, required by both state statute and local ordinance. All loads are subject to inspection. A current sticker is required for entry.

*No cash* is accepted at the Transfer Station. Payments *only* for disposal of items may be made with check or Visa/Mastercard/Discover cards.

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

If in doubt, please ask a staff member

1. Does the Transfer Station take GRASS & BRUSH?  
*NO, it does not.*
2. What if I put stuff in the wrong bin?  
*DON'T! It will contaminate the other materials. Notify a staff member if this occurs.*
3. Can empty cereal boxes, paper towel tubes, and junk mail with windows be recycled?  
*YES. They should all be put in the Mixed Paper container.*
4. Which plastic containers can be recycled?  
*ONLY food and beverage containers marked #1 – #7, up to 3 gallons in size.  
NO "Styrofoam" containers or cups, NO black plastic, NO plastic bags.*

Many of these items are collected at Household Hazardous Waste Days which will be held in Torrington in the Fall of 2011 and in Falls Village in the Spring of 2012.
