**Transfer Station Guide 2016-2017**

**The Transfer Station is for garbage and recyclables only from Salisbury & Sharon**

Whether or not you use a hauler, *recycling is mandatory*, required by both state statute and local ordinance. Each household is required to buy a sticker, regardless of whether a hauler is used. All loads are subject to inspection. A current sticker is required for entry.

**No cash is accepted at the Transfer Station. Payments only for disposal of items may be made with check or Visa/Mastercard/Discover cards.**

**Frequently Asked Questions**

If in doubt, please ask a staff member

1. Do I need a sticker on my car?  
*Yes, staff will affix it to your windshield.*
2. Which plastics can be recycled?  
**ONLY food and beverage containers marked #1 – #7, up to 3 gallons in size. NO foam containers or cups, NO black plastic, NO plastic bags, NO plant pots.**
3. What if I put stuff in the wrong bin?  
**DON'T! It will contaminate the other materials. Notify a staff member if this occurs.**

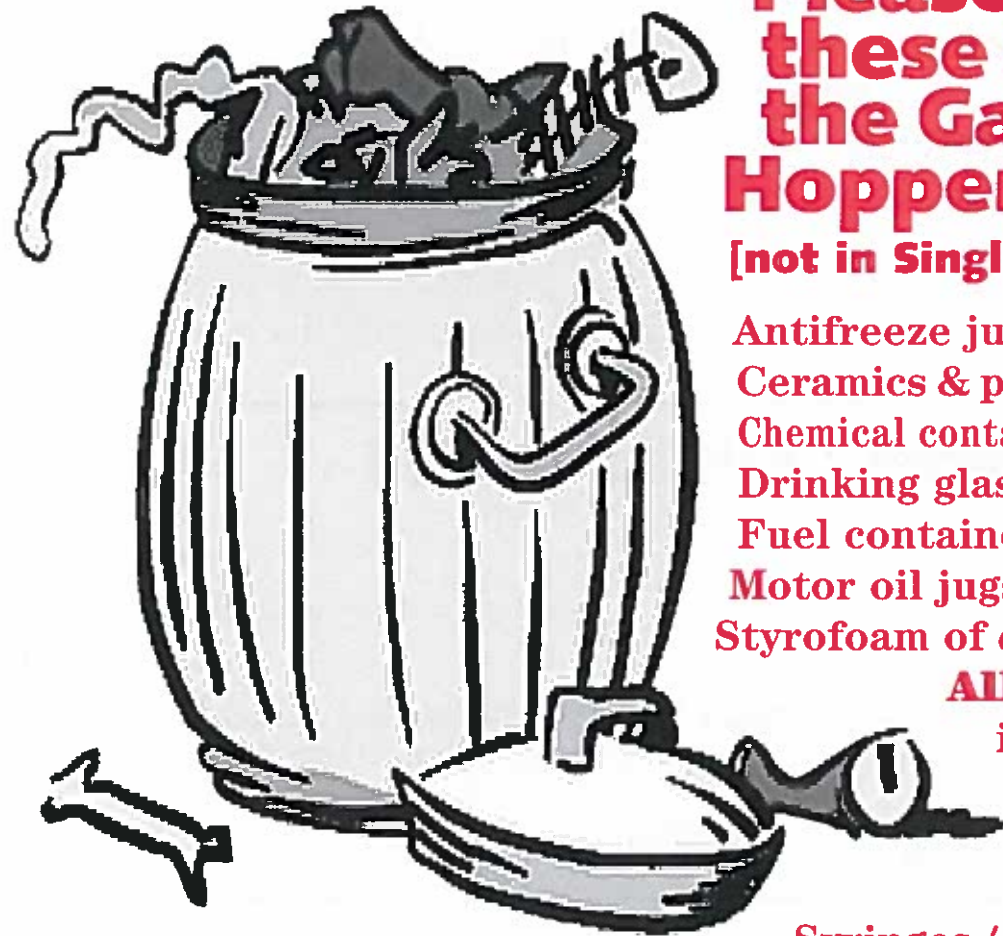

# The Salisbury/Sharon Transfer Station accepts Single Stream Recycling

Single Stream Recycling [SSR] allows curbside recycling to be combined into one recycling bin. Paper, cardboard, bottles, and cans can all be co-mingled together. Other names for SSR are Zero-Sort, and Fully Co-mingled Recycling.

**If you don't know if something is recyclable, ask—  
our staff doesn't bite!**



## Please throw these items in the Garbage Hopper:

[not in Single Stream]

- Antifreeze jugs [empty]
- Ceramics & pottery dishes
- Chemical containers [empty]
- Drinking glasses
- Fuel containers [empty]
- Motor oil jugs [empty]
- Styrofoam of *any* kind

- All black plastic,**  
including plant pots
- All plastic bags**
- Drink straws
- Pizza boxes
- Syringes / needles

**Now, large plastic items such as toys, recycling bins, coolers,  
baskets, containers & buckets can go in SSR container.**

### Items **NOT** accepted at the Transfer Station:

Household hazardous waste, or other toxic chemicals, including: Anti-freeze, asbestos, gasoline, pool chemicals, oven & drain cleaners, acids and caustic materials. Many of these items are collected at the **Household Hazardous Waste Days** which will be held in Torrington in Fall 2016, and in Falls Village in late Spring, 2017. Contact your Town Hall for details.
