

SALISBURY AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMISSION

SPECIAL MEETING

JANUARY 27, 2021 7:30 – 9:30PM (VIA ZOOM)

The meeting was called to order at 7:32pm. Present: Jennifer Kronholm Clark, Mary Close Oppenheimer, Jim Dresser, Pom Shillingford, Ethan Watt and Pat Hackett

J. Kronholm Clark, Chairman, explained how the meeting would be run, with participants submitting questions using the chat function during the question & answer period. Comments would be limited to 3 minutes per person, to accommodate the large number of attendees. She also explained that this was an informational meeting, not a public hearing.

1) Salisbury Affordable Housing Plan – a presentation

M. Close Oppenheimer began the presentation with a brief explanation of the new 2019 Planning & Zoning regulations with regard to housing. She described the May, 2018 Salisbury Affordable Housing Plan, including goals and facts. The plan is on the Town website. She stopped her presentation at that point.

J. Kronholm Clark explained that the 100 participant limit on regular Zoom meetings had been reached. There was discussion about trying to continue the meeting on a new Zoom link provided by M. Close Oppenheimer. The new link was immediately displayed on the screen, posted to the SAHC Facebook page and emailed to some who had phoned into the meeting. However, the number of participants exceeded the limit on the new link also. After many comments, the consensus was to re-schedule the entire meeting to Thursday, February 4, 2021 at 7:30pm.
