HISTORIC DISTRICTS COMMISSION

JANUARY 5, 2021 – 9:00AM (ZOOM)

- 1) Call to Order. Present: Carol Mason, Tom Callahan, Elyse Harney and Robert Highsmith.
- 2) **Approval of Agenda. So Moved** by T. Callahan, seconded by R. Highsmith and unanimously **Approved**.
- 3) Approval of Minutes of November 10, 2020 meeting.
Item #5 was corrected to read: "C. Mason read a letter...." T. Callahan added that there was no outreach yet. A **Motion to Approve the Minutes of November 10, 2020, as corrected**, was made by T. Callahan, seconded by C. Mason and unanimously **Approved**.
- 4) T. Callahan provided an update on the Pope Land Committee (PLC) report given to the Board of Selectmen on 1/4/21. He reviewed the charge of the PLC and noted that the PLC member's comments were included unedited, as they were submitted. After final review from the PLC members, the report, with any additional comments, will be ready for the BoS. T. Callahan read his portion of the report relating to the Salisbury Historic District. E. Harney commended T. Callahan for his work on the project.

Susan Galluzzo, a member of the Lakeville Community Conservancy, spoke about their message of preserving the character of the Lakeville historic area. She indicated that they would like to work with others on the profile of historic buildings and neighborhoods. They would like to raise the profile of heritage, health and vitality in Lakeville. She mentioned that Rachel Carley had done a report for them which she would send to T. Callahan for the SHDC. She added that they would like to have an established walking trail in Lakeville. E. Harney pointed out that the Salisbury Association might have a copy of a brochure that had been done, including a walking map. She also mentioned that the SHDC has had an annual event for several years for Salisbury Historic District property owners. The Salisbury Association will be contacted about the brochure and map.
