Call to order -- 5:30 p.m.

1. Approval of the minutes of March 8, 2021.  
Minutes approved unanimously.
  
2. Status of the Connectivity Grant:
  - a. Inland/Wetland Commission approved our application to cross the brook (Mark Mancini and Chris Williams were present at the meeting and answered questions pertaining to the grant).
  - b. Curtis Rand met twice with MacGowans, property owners of 223 Main Street. They received our answers to their questions. Shielding is considered. Electric dog fence will be moved.
  - c. New issue: 2 red maple trees are in the way of the project. One of them may be saved. Mark Mancini is working on the consideration of how to go about it.
  - d. New issue: blue PVC pipe at the brook. Dave Clark, DOT, is working on determining what that pipe is and, if possible, how to remove it.
  - e. One more discussion about whether or not to have a Town Meeting about this project.
    - i. We have made numerous announcements in Lakeville Journal about it through time (from 2018).
    - ii. The letter to abutters (or anyone) informing about the groundbreaking this spring is available on the Town's website.
    - iii. All the work is within State ROW  
➔ no Town Meeting is needed.
  - f. We need to obtain Right to Grade from the property owners of 223 Main Street. This will be done by DOT. Prior owners knew about the project. Pat Hackett talked to prior owner about the project.
  - g. After new issues are resolved and Right to Grade is obtained, we are ready to break ground. Now: maybe June.
  
3. Status of Library to Salmon Kill Road Sidewalk:  
Waiting for the engineering firm to put grade stacks in. After that – RFP will be issued.
  
4. Citizens comments.
