 - T. Callahan pointed out that changing from natural wood to composite decking costs more upfront and asked what color it will be; the answer was white. He also asked if the street-facing trim could be wood; Michael Voldstad answered, no, that is where the wood rots. M. C. Taylor asked if there is a big difference in board width between the wood and the composite; Kathy Voldstad answered that the composite boards are actually the same look and width, 3.5" tongue & groove. There is no trim, only the board ends are visible.
