There was an additional \$25-30k approved by the BOS for the flood study and hydraulic analysis that CTDEEP required. Project is expected to be bid out this Spring for a Spring start.
3. Status of Library to Salmon Kill Road Sidewalk.
There was a bid opening on September 27th with three bids, Progressive for \$53, 840, Metcalf for \$75, 440, and Mather for \$125,000. The BOS voted to accept the low-bid at their October 4 meeting. Work is planned to start this coming Spring.
4. Re-appointment of Gerry Stanton and Pat Hackett (terms expire 11/2021).
Pat made a motion to appoint Gerry Stanton for another term and Chris seconded it. Chris and Pat voted in favor. Gerry made a motion to appoint Pat Hackett for another term and Chris seconded it. Chris and Gerry voted in favor. Names will go to the BOS
5. Citizens comments.

A question concerning the flashing beacon project for the 2 Salisbury crosswalks and the Salmon Kill Road crossing at the Ramble was brought up at our last meeting. The project will not occur this construction season and will take place this coming Spring.
