In approximately 2013, the P&Z received a grant of \$39,860 to conduct a study of the Incentive Zone (IHZ) program and whether there were parcels of land in the Salisbury village that could be used as an IHZ. The study seemed to concentrate on the areas behind LaBonne's and near the town garage. In the end, P&Z decided not to adapt this IHZ program or designation.

In approximately 2018 the P&Z engaged the firm AKRF to amend its regulations with respect to housing densities but these were with town funds, no grants, and this did not involve IHZs. (Town Meeting minutes attached)
