Pat is in communication with Brian and Kevin from Metcalf. They plan to start the work the week of the 19th or the 26th. The invoice for \$11,088 for the first 254 feet of the sidewalk is attached. Hopefully, this will be done before the winter.

Chris will work with Curtis to notify property owners along the work site.

4. Citizens comments.

Mr. Robert Highsmith of the property along the proposed sidewalk from the Library to the Meadow thanked the Committee for their multiyear efforts creating a walkability opportunity along Route 41/44. He emphasized the importance of taking care of the tree that is in front of his property along the proposed sidewalk. Chris reassured Mr. Highsmith that the sidewalk will loop around the tree and will not affect it. The tree will be preserved. The flower bed that is in the way will be relocated to be inside the property.

5. New Business – none was discussed.
