




3. Search by property owner name, address, or map/lot on the left-hand portion of the screen OR select "Interactive Mapping" to explore an area



4. Once in the viewer, select layers from the dropdown menus on the upper right to view additional information. The current underlying zoning information, effective October 17, 2022 is now available. Note that, Assessor records may not match (See step 5).



5. Select a parcel to see specific details such as address, owner, map/lot, and acreage. In the example below, the Assessor's information does not match. The correct zoning on this piece is R-20.



Making the zoning layer available through the GIS is the first of several steps towards making Land Use resources remotely accessible and more user friendly. This is a work in progress that requires collaboration with several departments and commissions. Periodic updates will be forthcoming.
