

Lakeville Village Planning Study Public Engagement Questions

The planning professionals at Colliers Engineering & Design (CED) are working with the Town of Salisbury's Planning and Zoning Commission to evaluate the existing conditions in Lakeville village. The <u>study area</u> is located between the Grove and Salmon Kill Road, and between Rte. 44 and the Rail Trail.

Based on your responses CED will develop recommendations for enhancements and mitigations targeted at the five study parameters outlined as follows.

1. Pedestrian and bicycle access, circulation, and safety
