- 1. Call to Order. Present: Tom Callahan, Elyse Harney, Robert Highsmith, M.C. Taylor and Heidi Hoeller (Alternate). Absent: Carol Mason
- 2. Approval of Agenda. So Moved by R. Highsmith, seconded by E. Harney and unanimously Approved.
- 3. Approval of the Minutes of May 2 and May 9, 2023. So Moved by E. Harney, seconded by R. Highsmith and unanimously Approved.
- 4. <u>Public Hearing</u> / COA Applications #2023-007 & 2023-008 / Congregational Church / Replacement of One Existing & 3 New HVAC Units / Option A & Option B Mark Robbins, MHR Development LLC, briefly described the proposed replacements. Option A would have all of the units in the same location; Option B would have them in various locations. A Motion to Open the Public Hearing was made by E. Harney, seconded by R. Highsmith and unanimously Approved. There was no further discussion. A Motion to Close the Public Hearing was made by E. Harney, seconded by R. Highsmith and unanimously Approved. There were no further comments. A Motion to Approve COA Applications #2023-007 & 2023-008 for Replacement HVAC Units, Option A & Option B, was made by M.C. Taylor, seconded by R. - 5. <u>Public Hearing</u> / COA Application #2023-006 / Congregational Church / Installation of One Dual-Port Electric Vehicle Charger on Library Street Mark Robbins, MHR Development LLC, described the proposed EV Charger; it would be a white stanchion with no moving parts.  Public Hearing / COA Application #2023-009 / 84 Main Street (The Buckley House) / Renovation of Existing 19<sup>th</sup>-Century Barn Structure

- <u>COA Application #2023-012</u> / 84 Main Street (The Buckley House) / Construction of New Shed R. Highsmith, Owner, described the proposed cedar shed. It would be used to store trash and other items. It would be located at the end of the driveway, in the back at the right rear of the property; the top of it might be visible. It would have 2 sections with a passageway between them. The size would be approximately 16' wide; height 8'x10". It would sit on a gravel pad. A Motion to Accept COA Application #2023-012, was made by H. Hoeller, seconded by E. Harney and unanimously Approved. A Public Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at 9:05am.
