Call to order – 5:30 p.m.

1. Approval of the minutes of the meeting on May 8, 2023.
Minutes approved unanimously.
2. Status of the Connectivity Grant.
 - The Town is working with Rob and Tracy Macgowan, property owners of 223 Main Street Lakeville, to prepare for the installation of the sidewalk based on agreements reached in 2021. The improperly installed Invisible Fence will be moved from the State Right-of-Way to the actual property. The other prior-agreed-upon items will be done in time for the groundbreaking in the Fall.
 - The Town of Salisbury Project Inspector is identified and is working with the contractor preparing the starting permit.
 - Bridge color: The committee was set on a dark green, so we propose #35115 and if that is unavailable then #14066. (Email from Curtis Rand to DCCI dcci@dayton-construction.com sent May 15, 2023)
3. Status of the Transportation Rural Improvement Program (TRIP) application.
Decision on the TRIP grant will be made in September.
During the Selectmen meeting in June, due to the surplus of funds, the town transferred \$50,000 to Pathways Committee budget line.
4. Letter to Abutters for The Connector – Kathy and Gerry.

5. Citizens comments: No citizens were present.
