We would also like to point out several other issues with the Drifting weekend.

• There was no promised police presence on Lime Rock and White Hollow roads. According to one Police Officer at the Canaan barracks, they were hired to be present only inside the Track, to prevent fights. This left Lime Rock Road, White Hollow Road and Rt 7 to be used by Gridlife patrons as "Racing Practice" with speeding witnessed on all roads leading to and from the track.

• There were no flashing posted speed limit signs on Lime Rock Rd and White Hollow Rd as promised. Earlier conversations with LRCC indicated your intent to purchase these signs for track purposes, not just borrowing from the Town of Salisbury when they are available.

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
