Answers to Land trust bridge questions.

The photo is just an example of a log bridge.
A tree for the bridge will be cut on site near the crossing location.
The span is 25 feet.

Locust sills would be set back 2-3 feet from the stream edge and anchored with 4' rebar
No soil disturbance on the banks.
The sill ends are high up on the banks above the high water marks of recent heavy flooding.
There will be no encroachment into the stream or bank sides.

The stream flows in a straight line in the bridge area.

The work would be done by Greenagers


