ATTENTION BOATERS

HELP STOP THE SPREAD OF HYDRILLA

HYDRILLA IS RAPIDLY SPREADING THROUGHOUT CT AND HAS BEEN RECENTLY FOUND IN NEARBY WATERS. It grows quickly and forms dense patches. It can displace native plants, impact fish and wildlife habitat, and interfere with boating, paddling and fishing.

BEFORE LEAVING THE LAUNCH:



CLEAN

All aquatic plants and other debris from boat and trailer and dispose of properly.



DRAIN

All water from your boat and trailer.

AT HOME OR PRIOR TO NEXT LAUNCH:



DRY

For a minimum of 1 week in hot/ dry weather or 4 weeks in cool/wet weather.

IT'S THE LAW! It is illegal to transport on a boat or trailer ANY VEGETATION and the following aquatic invasive species (CGS 15-180): Zebra Mussel, Quagga mussel, Chinese mitten crab, New Zealand mud snail, Asian clam, Rusty crayfish (see RCSA 26-55-5). THE FINE FOR EACH VIOLATION IS \$95.00.



OR WASH

Everything that had contact with the water with hot high-pressure water, a salt solution, 100% vinegar, 10% bleach, or detergent.
