

Rules and Regulations

- No one 12 years of age or under will be allowed unless they are supervised by a responsible person (14 years of age or older).
- NO DOGS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME – THIS INCLUDES IN VEHICLES.
- Cell Phone users please be considerate of others and your surroundings.
- Generally, only audio devices utilizing earphones will be allowed. Inconsiderate use of radios will not be tolerated.
- Bicycles, skateboards and scooters are prohibited on beach, walkways and parking lots. All bikes should be parked in the bike racks.
- Ball playing, frisbee throwing or running is limited to open spaces.
- Floatation devices are only allowed in the enclosed kiddie area.

The Management of the Grove will not allow any of the following activities:

- Abusive Language
- Littering
- Sand Throwing
- Fighting
- Loitering in the store
- Entering Unauthorized Areas
- Distracting Lifeguards on-duty
- Defacing Property
- Excessive Driving Speeds
- Indecent Acts
- Weapons of any kind
- Drugs and/or Alcohol

Anyone who violates any of the above may be asked to leave the park.

Season Stickers

On sale seven days a week at the Town Grove Boathouse starting Memorial Day Weekend.

1. Proof of Residency is required (see “Residents Defined” below)
2. Registration form must be completed.
3. Grove Staff must affix all stickers.

Residents Defined

1. Taxpayers in the township of Salisbury.
2. Private school staff and people who reside on campus.
3. Renters of apartments or homes in Salisbury who are renting for at least one month.
4. A person must LIVE in the house in Town in order to be considered a resident. All others are guest and must pay a fee.
5. All guest must ride with a resident - only exceptions, car seat issues or handicap issues.

Fees and Rates

Sticker Fees:

Resident - \$85.00 for 1st sticker (any additional stickers - \$55.00)
Senior Citizens (65+) - \$55.00
Non-resident - \$420.00
Daily Entry - \$15.00 per person (under one year of age FREE)

Non-Resident Stickers:

Non-residents may purchase a season pass for \$420.00 (beach privileges only). All other privileges are extra (example - boat launch).

Individual Admission and Guest Fee:

Gives use of the beach, playground, picnic areas and dressing rooms. Admission fee is \$15.00 per person (children under one are free).

Hydrilla is rapidly spreading throughout CT and has been recently found in nearby waters. It grows quickly and forms dense patches. It can displace native plants, impact fish and wildlife habitat, and interfere with boating, paddling and fishing.

BEFORE LEAVING THE LAUNCH:

Clean all aquatic plants and other debris from boat and trailer and dispose of properly.

Drain all water from your boat and trailer

AT HOME OR PRIOR TO NEXT LAUNCH:

Dry for a minimum of 1 week in hot/dry weather or 4 weeks in cool/wet weather

or

Wash everything that had contact with the water with hot high-pressure water, salt solution, 100% vinegar, 10% bleach, or detergent.

IT'S THE LAW! It is illegal to transport on a boat or trailer ANY VEGETATION and aquatic invasive species (CGS-15-180).
THE FINE FOR EACH VIOLATION IS \$95.00
