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BOS – Minutes – 6.2.2025

The Board of Selectmen Regular Meeting minutes of June 2, 2025.

Present: Curtis Rand, First Selectman; Christian Williams, Selectman; Katherine Kiefer, Selectman; Emily Egan, Administrative Assistant; members of the press and public.

The meeting was **called to order** at 5:00pm.

C. Williams made a motion to **approve the agenda** with the addition of (#8) an Executive Session for a pending claim. K. Kiefer seconded, and the agenda was approved as amended.

C. Williams made a motion to **approve the minutes** of the May 5, 2025 (Regular Meeting), the May 15, 2025 (Special Meeting) and the May 21, 2025 (Special Meeting). K. Kiefer seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

First Selectman Report

- C. Rand mentioned that the Lime Rock Park NASCAR hauler parade will be at 4:30pm on June 26th, 2025. The NASCAR truck event will follow on June 27th and 28th at Lime Rock Park. Route 112 (Lime Rock Road) will have detours on both days.
- The Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day will be on Saturday, June 21st, 2025 at the Falls Village Public Works Department from 9am-12pm. Tickets are available at the Selectman's Office.
- The Selectmen are waiting on the reports from the Road Safety Audit.
- C. Rand will be reaching out to the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) to see if they can contribute to repairs on the foundation and brickwork on the façade of the CNE Railroad Station.
- C. Rand also reminded everyone that the Assessor's revaluation will be taking place this summer.

New Business

- a. Brian Bartram, Transfer Station Manager, Barbara Bettigole, Chairman of TRAC and Kristen Brown of WasteZero, gave a brief overview on the Sustainable Materials Management Round 2 (SMMR2) Grant Program. Kristen Brown explained the four program phases and will work with the Town to gather data and statistics needed to write the application. The Town of Sharon also approved applying for the grant. If the grant is received, both towns will appoint a committee to design a town-specific waste reduction program. C. Williams made a motion that the Board of Selectmen support and approve applying for the SMMR2. K. Kiefer seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- b. The Selectmen received correspondence from Vivian Garfein, Chairman of Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission (IWWC) updating the Selectmen on projects and accomplishments over the past few months, including adopting revised regulations. The Selectmen thanked Vivian and the Commission for all their hard work.
- c. The Selectmen moved, seconded and approved unanimously the following tax refunds as recommended by the Tax Collector: June 2, 2025, a total of \$945.88. (Smith, L \$44.00; Jerome, M. \$901.88).

Selectmen's Reports

C. Williams gave a brief overview on the new Connectivity Grant that Salisbury Pathways Committee (SPC) applied for in May. SPC is also waiting on the final plans for the connection from Lakeville to Salisbury and Route 41 (Undermountain Road from Salisbury to Cobble Road).

Citizen Comments

There were none at this time.

C. Williams made a motion to go into **Executive Session** inviting E. Egan and B. Bartram to join the Selectmen. K. Kiefer seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

K. Kiefer made a motion to come out of Executive Session. C. Williams seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
