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Good Afternoon,

As stated by the Chair at last night's meeting our expectation is that some (if not all) of the Intervenor's experts will present at the beginning of the meeting on Tuesday 8/19. The application materials have been available for ample time and some of the Intervenor's experts have been noted in attendance (Miller and Brooks) at prior hearings. While the Chair accepts that Mr. Brooks may need additional preparation time as the acoustical portion of the hearing has been evolving, he sees no reason why Mr. Miller, Mr. Logan, and Mr. Rawlings cannot present their complete findings on Tuesday.

The Chair is very cognizant of his obligation to run a fair and impartial process that affords all parties their due process. However, he is also aware that delays posed by an untimely intervention deprive other parties of their due process rights.

The Chair sees no reason why it will take four days to assemble a verified petition for intervention having personally created such petitions in a matter of hours during his 40 years of professional land use practice. Therefore, we expect the Cruger's verified petition for intervention to be received no later than Monday August 18th at noon. The Chair also requests a list of witnesses the Intervenor will present on Tuesday August 19th and a subsequent list of experts to present at the meeting on August 26th (also no later than August 18th at noon). It is his goal to cover the Intervenor's testimony in those two meetings to allow all parties the ability to engage in a constructive dialog concerning matters directly related to the testimony of the Intervenor's experts.

The Chair also wishes to point out that he extended great latitude to the Intervenor during the original application which has been, at Mr. Mackey's request has been included in its entirety into the record of these proceedings. He is requesting your cooperation in ensuring that all testimony presented in this second application be directly relevant to the allegations of the intervention. As has been the Chair's request of the Applicant and the Commission, please focus on matters that have substantively changed from the previous application to the new application.
