I just read the latest letter from you to Attorney Grimes on Friday admonishing him for submitting materials late on a Friday afternoon, just a few days before the next scheduled public hearing.

For the record, the entire community, including abutting neighbors, learned of this project last year just before the Labor Day weekend. The commission had been aware of it for months already. The certified mailing went out on August 19 and the public hearing commenced September 3. As you know, many folks around here are part-time residents and do not get mail delivered to them on a daily basis. Therefore, they did not know about the entire development until the public hearing was beginning.

Also, the revised package of 644 pages of documentation from the applicants was submitted to the commission on April 30 and the first meeting of the commission to discuss it was six days later on May 5.

I understand that we are all anxious to get to the finish line on this ordeal, and I can't thank the commission enough for the tremendous amount of time committed to this one project, but timing has been an issue for a year now. If a 644 page document can be digested in a matter of six days, surely we can handle a 13 page document over a couple of days? Thank you.
