Dear Attorney Grimes:

Prior to the long weekend (8/29/2025) I wrote to you about cross examination of your experts and Aradev's experts. It was and still is my preference to direct those cross examination questions through the Chair.

It is your intent to avail yourself of my offer? Or would you prefer another avenue to get the answers your need?

I am trying to arrange a schedule for tomorrow night's continued hearing. As the public had very little time at the last hearing, it is my intention to lead with public comment. But if you wish to ask questions of the experts, I intend to lead with your questions, then go to the public, and then the applicant, and finally the PZC will ask questions of any and of all the experts (i.e., Aradev's and Cruger's).

### **Additional information for all interested parties:**

#### **September 9th:**

The continuation of the hearing will be on the 9th. That continuation will begin at 6 PM.

My preference for the final evening (9th) would be reserved for summations.

I anticipate that the final evening should take no more than two hours, hopefully less.

At that meeting I will identify the voting members of the PZC (5) who will deliberate. As before non-voting PZC members will not be in the Webinar but can observe the subsequent deliberations as a member of the public.

#### **Deliberations:**

There is a large volume of material that the PZC needs to read and re-read. While there is always a concern about *ex parte* communications with the commissioners, as I understand from various PZC members, the public has not approached them about these issues at any other venues where they "bump into one another." In order to be fully prepared for the deliberations--I think is reasonable to begin these several weeks after the close of the hearing. Late September-early October.
