As you are all aware tonight is the last night that we can legally hold the hearing open. It is my intent to conduct tonight's hearing as follows:

1. Open the hearing--accept the special meeting agenda by vote.
2. New information received will be read into the record including the Logan submission sent to us by Attorney Grimes late yesterday. Any comments/questions from Attorney Andres will be received prior to summations and Mr. Andres is free to interject as he deems necessary during tonight's proceedings.
3. Summation -- William Cruger (Mr. Cruger requested at the last meeting that he will do the summation for himself and the neighbors *instead* of Attorney Grimes).
4. Summation -- ARADEV-Attorney Mackey.
5. Seating of voting Commissioners for deliberations. We will not begin deliberations until early October. Each Commissioner will be individually asked on the record if they have attended all the hearings and/or listened to the tape recordings of meetings they missed and that they are each able to render a decision in an objective, impartial manner, free from any prejudice or bias.
6. Restating the prohibition on *ex parte* communication.
7. Close of hearing -- by vote. No additional information may be entered into the record. The PZC is able to receive advice after the close of the hearing from its consultants with the strict proviso that no new topics (i.e., topics not in the record) are discussed.

Notes:

A. All information submitted until the hearing closes will be part of the record. The PZC will review anything that has been received in writing since the last hearing date, September 4th through the close of hearing tonight, during their deliberations.

B. If either party wants to comment on the most recent submissions they should do so in writing--or in the summations. It is my preference that additional expert testimony, beyond the summations by Mr. Cruger and Attorney Mackey, be presented in writing before the formal close of the hearing.

C. It is not my intent to allow additional questions from the PZC unless there is something that must be asked (i.e., not in the written record).

D. If this hearing continues beyond 8 PM I will turn the hearing over to Vice Chair Shyer and I will review the last part of tonight's hearing (post 8 PM) via the tape. Hopefully that will not be necessary. For the record, I have attended all the hearings and am able to render a decision in an objective, impartial manner free from any prejudice or bias.
