

SALISBURY RECREATION COMMISSION
Meeting May 13, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. Present were Lou Bucceri, Becky Lachaine, Lisa McAuliffe, Raydin Neary, Jon Russillo, Tim Sinclair, and Danny Smith. Chairman Bucceri presided.

Danny moved that the agenda for the meeting be approved as written. Jon seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously. Danny moved to approve the April 8, 2025 meeting minutes as written. Tim seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously.

Lisa reported that registration for summer programs is open. The first open pickleball started tonight with ten people participating. Region 1 tennis started and has approximately twelve participants. Lisa had to cancel the second session due to rain. Adult lap swim continues to be well attended.

No new progress has been made on the Pope Property. On hold waiting for the Wood Turtle report.

Lisa happily reported that work is in progress on the new pickleball courts down at Trotta Field. The cement has been poured and needs 35-40 days to cure before the surface can be painted and fencing put up.

Danny asked about the plan for Community Field and if any progress has been made on that front. A survey has been completed but we cannot move forward with anything until we know what is happening with the Pope Property. The single tennis will need to be moved off of the water company's property and the double courts are beginning to form large cracks and they will be unplayable in a year or two. Lisa is hoping to move on this project as soon as possible.

No financial report was available at the time of the meeting, but Lisa assured us that she had not spent much since the last report, and we are financially sound.

Jon moved to adjourn at 7:41 p.m. The motion was seconded by Raydin and unanimously approved.
