Colleagues:

I have been thinking about the best way to approach sifting through the voluminous record of this application.

I think we can create some structure to our deliberations if each of us comes with their PRELIMINARY thoughts and topics for exploration and discussion.

Our attorney will be there to advise and guide us. We also have access to our engineering and acoustic consultants.

We can discuss (and inquire of our consultants) topics that are in the record. If there is a question as to whether a line of inquiry is supported by the record we will defer to Attorney Andres' guidance.

What I propose, and this is certainly open to modification by the group, is that we each come to the initial deliberative meeting with a synopsis of what each of us would like to focus on in the first round of deliberations. What I would hope to be the outcome of this is a framework for our discussions --- I want to see us ideally address topics in an organized manner. Explore one and then move to the next rather than jumping back and forth. Maybe this won't be possible-- but I'd like to give it a try.

I propose that we each spend between 5-10 minutes each discussing our respective lists of topics and overall assessment of what the salient issues that require in depth exploration are.

I also propose that we follow the order as follows:

Vice Chair Shyer
Secretary Whalen
Member Cockerline
Member Riva

I think that by going through this process we will identify those topics that require further exploration.

I would ask that this email *not be answered* but serve as a template for Tuesday night's first round of deliberations.

Thank you for your consideration of these ideas which we can discuss in the public meeting on Tuesday night.
