BOS – Minutes – 9.29.2025

The Board of Selectmen Special Meeting minutes of September 29, 2025.

Present: Curtis Rand, First Selectman; Christian Williams, Selectman; Katherine Kiefer, Selectman.

The meeting was **called to order** at 5:00pm.

Selectmen's Reports

The Selectmen decided to cancel the October 6th Regular Meeting.

C. Rand mentioned he spoke with the Connecticut Dept. of Transportation about a corridor study for Route 44 and Route 41, because that was recommended in the Road Safety Audit. CT DOT said that has to go through the Northwest Hills Council of Governments (NHCOG). NHCOG will look into this for us.

New Business

a. The Local Capital Improvement Program (LoCIP) distributes formula-based funds to municipalities for eligible local capital improvement projects. The current 5-year plan is coming to an end, and we are allowed to make a new plan at any time. The projects that are anticipated, should be in the plan. However, the Town had to replace the boiler in the Town Hall. Due to the circumstances of cold weather approaching, the immediate need to replace the system and a contractor having the availability to do the project, we would like to request the Office of Policy and Management to consider allowing us to include this project in our LoCIP Plan, if the Selectmen approve this capital improvement. K. Kiefer made a motion to approve this boiler replacement, not to exceed, \$46,000.00. C. Williams seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

b. The Salisbury Association has requested the Selectmen support two applications for Open Space grants for preservation of 63 acres of land along the Housatonic River owned by White Hollow Farms, Inc and 96 acres of the Hewat land in Salisbury. Preservation of these parcels is consistent with our Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD). C. Williams made a motion to approve the support letters for the Open Space grants. K. Kiefer seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
