**WPCA – Minutes – 3.17.2026**

The Water Pollution Control Authority Regular Meeting minutes of March 17, 2026.

**Present:** Donald Mayland, Chairman; John Whalen; Pat Hackett; Emily Egan; Charles Humes, Superintendent.

**Absent:** James Rutledge; Robin Leech.

The meeting was **called to order** at 9:00am.

P. Hackett made a motion to **approve the agenda**. D. Mayland seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

P. Hackett made a motion to **approve the minutes** from January 14, 2026 and January 20, 2026. J. Whalen seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

**Superintendent's Report**

C. Humes provided an update on several maintenance and infrastructure items:

- **Pump Maintenance:** Reported clogs in the pumps connecting the clarifier to the aeration tank.
- **Jetting:** Maintenance jetting several targeted areas in Salisbury.
- **Flow Levels:** Noted increased flow rates during recent peak rainfall.
- **Facility Repairs:** Identified a necessary roof repair for the digester building.

**Chairman's Report**

D. Mayland requested an update regarding infiltration and inflow (I&I). C. Humes reported the following:

- **American Rooter:** The company is capable of installing sock liners from the mains through the laterals. Quotes for this work are currently pending.
- **Tighe & Bond:** C. Humes contacted Erin Moore, who is re-evaluating previous flow data to identify high-priority areas for mitigation.

**Discussion of Connections and Fees**

- **16 East Street, Lakeville:** The WPCA granted pre-approval for a new single-family connection.
- **9 + 9A Sharon Road:** Following a request from the Tax Collector, the WPCA approved a shift in billing for July 2026. The restaurant will transition from square-footage billing to gallon-based billing. The upstairs apartment (unmetered) will maintain a flat fee, and the 9A building will continue to be billed by square footage. The Tax Collector will be notified of this approval.

**Budget 2026–2027**

The Authority reviewed the current and proposed budgets. C. Humes noted that an increase is required for the "Legal Fees" line item.
