Dear Commissioners,

I am writing in regard to the public hearing # 2026-0315 Lime Rock Park II, LLC / Regulation Amendment.

On May 12th, 2026, the Connecticut Superior Court approved a joint agreement (stipulation) between Lime Rock Park (LRP) and Lime Rock Citizens Council (LRCC). This amended stipulated injunction upholds a ban on Sunday racing and sets new operating rules for unmuffled engines, drifting and limited non-racing Sunday events. This agreement represents years of dedicated negotiation and hard earned compromise between LRP and LRCC.

The agreement balances the cultural and economic importance of LRP, with the peace, safety and the property rights of the surrounding community. This stipulation is the result of reciprocal concessions, and while it may not entirely satisfy the ideal preference of every individual stakeholder, it represents a balanced court-approved resolution.

As the owner of a historic home in Lime Rock and a resident of over thirty years, I support the court-sanctioned regulation request as it was presented by LRP.
